ARC Principles Availability, Responsiveness, Continuity

1	Be Mission Driven	All staff and administrative actions and decisions should be guided by a clear focus on the wellbeing of the children and families served.
2	Be Results Oriented	Measure success by how much child and family wellbeing improves and use this data to drive decision-making and improvement.
3	Be Improvement Directed	Continually seek to be more effective, to eliminate barriers, and to foster change to improve the wellbeing of children and families.
4	Be Relationship Centered	Focus on relationships/networks in your organization, stakeholders, and family networks to affect child and family outcomes.
5	Be Participation Based	Get those with a stake (front-line staff) involved in key program decisions, solutions, and improvement efforts.
